

Listing Of Disciplinary Actions

The following is a list of Disciplinary Actions that have been set in place by the Disciplinary Board in the event of any serious fouls or misconduct occurring.

1. Serious foul play resulting in a red card will bring a minimum of one game suspension.
2. Serious attempt to injury will carry a greater than one game suspension.
3. Spitting at an opponent or any other person will carry a minimum two game suspension.
4. Offensive, insulting or abusive language will bring a 1-4 game suspension.
5. Violent Conduct- player vs. player (fighting) minimum 1-4 game suspension, longer suspension may be given upon review by the disciplinary board.
6. Receiving a second caution in the same match will result in a one game suspension.
7. Denying the opposing team a goal or an obvious goal scoring opportunity by deliberately handling the ball (except for the goalkeeper in his own penalty area) will result in a one game suspension (red card). (Except in the U8-U12 divisions, a yellow card is given).
8. Denying an obvious goal scoring opportunity by an opponent moving towards the player's goal by an offense, punishable by a free kick or a penalty kick will result in a one game suspension (red card) (except in the U8-U12 divisions, a yellow card is given).

All suspensions are subject to the review of the disciplinary committee and at their discretion the suspension may be extended up to and including expulsion from the league.

The severity of the suspension is going to be dependent upon: age, history, intent and severity of the offense.

Any offense that results in the sending off of any other participant including but not limited to coaches, spectators, parents, siblings etc. towards any other participant including but not limited to coaches, spectators, parents, siblings etc and referee will result in a 1-4 game suspension subject to the review of the disciplinary committee. Referees- all suspension will be directed by the disciplinary committee, minimum reprimand will be a training session with the chief referee to a maximum of expulsion from the league.
